#### Hardware Installation

- 1. Turn off the power to your computer.
- 2. Unplug the power cord and remove your computer's cover.
- 3. Remove the slot bracket from an available PCI slot.

- To install the card, carefully align the card's bus connector with the selected PCI slot on the motherboard. Push the board down firmly.
- 5. Replace the slot bracket's holding screw to secure the card.
- 6. Secure the computer cover and reconnect the power cord.

#### **Driver Installation**

- 1. Insert the provided CD into your CD-ROM drive.
- 2. At the Windows Desktop, click **Start**, and then **Run**.
- 3. When the prompt displays

For Windows XP/Vista/7/8 32-bit - Enter "D:\UGT-

**PC20PL\Windows\32Bit\PCISetup.exe**" (where "D" is the designation of your CD drive)

For Windows XP/Vista/7/8 64-bit - Enter "D:\UGT-

**PC20PL\Windows\64Bit\PCISetup.exe**" (where "D" is the designation of your CD drive)

4. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation.
